

Il giudizio universale - The Universal Judgement - Camillo De Nardis, arr. Franco Cesarini

Camillo De Nardis was born in Orsogna in the Italian region of Abruzzo. After obtaining a degree in composition at the Naples conservatory, he first taught there, and later became the deputy-director. Among his compositions, it is worth mentioning the *Stabat Mater*, inspired by Pergolesi's musical style.

In 1878, *Il giudizio universale* (The Universal Judgement) won the first prize at the competition for band composition held in Naples. Following the first "Congress of Music" held in a united Italy which took place in Naples on 15 September 1864, significant changes in the instrumentation of Italian military bands were decided. Alongside piccolos, flutes, oboes, clarinets, cornets, flugelhorns, trumpets, horns, trombones, B♭ tenor horns, euphoniums, contrabass and percussions, the new guidelines requested that the instrumentation also include an entire quintet of saxophones, from soprano to bass.

This composition, with its melodramatic style, is full of sudden changes of atmosphere, fugal passages, and cantabile themes, as well as imposing moments in fortissimo. To compose a piece as vigorous, and with such strong colours, the author was doubtless inspired by Giuseppe Verdi's *Requiem*. *Il giudizio universale* is an immortal example of original writing from the 19th century, which deserves to be present in the repertoire of concert bands throughout the world.

DEUTSCH

Camillo De Nardis wurde in Orsogna in den Abruzzen (Italien) geboren. Sein Studium am Konservatorium von Neapel schloss er mit einem Diplom in Komposition ab und arbeitete dann zunächst als Lehrer und später als Vizedirektor an diesem Konservatorium. Aus seinen Werken ist besonders das *Stabat Mater* hervorzuheben, zu dem er sich vom Musikstil Pergolesis inspirieren ließ.

Il giudizio universale gewann den ersten Preis beim Kompositionswettbewerb in Neapel 1878. Beim ersten „Congresso musicale italiano“ des geeinten Italiens am 15. September 1864 wurden bedeutende Änderungen in der Instrumentierung italienischer Militärchester beschlossen und in der Folge umgesetzt. Neben Piccolos, Flöten, Oboen, Klarinetten, Cornets, Flügelhörnern, Trompeten, Hörnern, Posaunen, Tenorhörnern in B, Euphoniums, Kontrabass und Schlagzeug sahen die neuen Richtlinien ein komplettes Saxophonquintett – vom Sopran- bis zum Basssaxophon – vor.

Diese melodramatische Komposition ist voll von plötzlichen Stimmungswechseln, fugalen Passagen und gesanglichen Themen sowie auch beeindruckenden Momenten in fortissimo. Zu diesem kraftvollen Stück mit seinen starken Farben ließ sich der Komponist zweifellos von Giuseppe Verdis *Requiem* inspirieren. *Il giudizio universale* ist ein unsterbliches Beispiel für die Kompositionskunst des 19. Jahrhunderts, das einen würdigen Platz im Repertoire von Blasorchestern der ganzen Welt verdient.

FRANÇAIS

Camillo De Nardis (1857–1951) est né à Orsogna dans la région des Abruzzes dans le centre de l'Italie. Après avoir obtenu un prix de composition au Conservatoire de Naples, il y intégra le corps enseignant, puis en fut nommé directeur-adjoint. Parmi ses compositions, on retiendra son *Stabat Mater* aux influences pergolesiennes.

En 1878, son poème symphonique, *Il giudizio universale* (*Le jugement dernier*), a été récompensé du premier prix du Concours de Composition pour Orchestres à Vent de Naples. À l'issue du premier Congrès des musiques italiennes qui s'était tenu le 15 septembre 1864, à Naples, dans une Italie unifiée, on procéda à d'importants changements dans la configuration des formations musicales italiennes. Hormis les piccolos, flûtes traversières, hautbois, clarinettes, cornets, bugles, trompettes, cors, trombones, barytons Si♭, euphoniums, contrebasse(s) et percussions, les nouvelles directives exigeaient l'adjonction d'un quintette de saxophones allant du saxophone soprano au saxophone basse.

Cette œuvre mélodramatique abonde en brusques changements d'atmosphère, passages fugués, thèmes expressifs et climats fortissimo très intenses. La puissance de la trame et la dynamique des couleurs s'apparentent au *Requiem* de Giuseppe Verdi. *Il giudizio universale* constitue un témoignage important de ce que fut la composition originale pour Orchestre à Vent au XIX^e siècle. À ce titre, elle mérite une place de choix dans le répertoire actuel des Orchestres d'Harmonie du monde entier.

Il giudizio universale - The Universal Judgement - Camillo De Nardis, arr. Franco Cesarini

NEDERLANDS

Camillo De Nardis werd geboren in Orsogna, in de Italiaanse regio Abruzzo (de Abruzzen). Nadat hij als componist afstudeerde aan het conservatorium van Napels, gaf hij daar eerst les en werd hij er later onderdirecteur. Zijn *Stabat Mater*, geïnspireerd door de componeerstijl van Pergolesi, is een van zijn meest vermeldenswaardige composities.

In 1878 won De Nardis met *Il giudizio universale* de eerste prijs in de wedstrijd voor blaasmuziekcompositie die in Napels werd gehouden. Na het eerste 'muziekcongres' dat plaatshad in een verenigd Italië, gehouden in Napels op 15 september 1864, werd besloten dat er aanzienlijke veranderingen zouden plaatsvinden in de instrumentatie van de Italiaanse militaire muziek. Naast piccolo's, fluiten, hobo's, klarinetten, cornetten, bugels, trompetten, hoorns, trombones, tenorhoorns in Bes, euphoniums, contrabas en slagwerk, schreven de nieuwe richtlijnen voor dat de bezetting ook een compleet kwintet van saxofoons behoorde te bevatten, van sopraan tot bas.

Deze compositie, in een melodramatische stijl, omvat veel plotse veranderingen van sfeer, fugatische passages en cantabile thema's, evenals indrukwekkende momenten in fortissimo. Bij het schrijven van zo'n krachtig werk, met zulke intense kleuren, was de componist ongetwijfeld geïnspireerd door het *Requiem* van Giuseppe Verdi. *Il giudizio universale* is een blijvend voorbeeld van de oorspronkelijke schrijfrant uit de 19e eeuw, die nog altijd een plaats verdient in het repertoire van harmonieorkesten over de hele wereld.

ITALIANO

Camillo De Nardis è nato ad Orsogna negli Abruzzi ed ha studiato al conservatorio di Napoli, dove ha conseguito il diploma di composizione. Rimase in seguito legato al conservatorio divenendo dapprima un insegnante ed in seguito vicedirettore dell'istituto. Di particolare rilievo nella sua produzione lo *Stabat Mater*, ispirato dalle forme musicali di Pergolesi.

Il giudizio universale vinse il primo premio al concorso di composizione per un'opera originale per banda, indetto a Napoli nel 1878. A seguito del primo "Congresso musicale italiano" dell'Italia unita, svoltosi il 15 settembre 1864 a Napoli, l'ordinamento prevedeva importanti modifiche dell'organico strumentale delle bande militari italiane. Accanto ad ottavino, flauti, oboi, clarinetti, cornette, flicorni, trombe, clavicorni, corni, tromboni, bombardini, bombardoni, contrabbassi e percussione, l'organico prevedeva ora anche l'uso di un intero quintetto di sassofoni, dal soprano al basso.

La composizione, con il suo stile melodrammatico, è ricca di bruschi cambiamenti d'atmosfera, passaggi in fugato, temi cantabili e grandiosi momenti in fortissimo. L'autore si è sicuramente ispirato al *Requiem* di Giuseppe Verdi, per dipingere un affresco dalle tinte forti e dal piglio vigoroso. Una pagina immortale del repertorio originale ottocentesco che merita di comparire nel repertorio delle bande di tutto il mondo.
